

# COURSES AVAILABLE WITH N2 MEMBERSHIP

N2 has a partnership with CITI to provide high quality, web-based, Canadian instruction on a variety of research topics. These courses promote research with human participants to be conducted in a manner that is appropriate, safe, responsible, ethical and meets the guidelines, regulations and legislation in this country. The 9-courses in the CITI-Canada curriculum are composed of modules and quizzes; completion certificates are generated for successful learners. Limited courses are available in both English and French.



## **Good Clinical Practice Basic** (EN)

Presents ICH-E6 R2-GCP standards as they relate to clinical trials. Includes regulations in Canada such as Health Canada Food and Drug Regulations-Division 5; the Tri-Council Policy Statement, and US Food & Drug Administration (FDA) regulatory requirements.



## **Good Clinical Practice Refresher** (EN & FR)

Includes a refresher of the Good Clinical Practice Basic course.



## **Biomedical Research Ethics** (EN)

Assists in the understanding and application of principles of ethics, ethics guidelines, regulations and legislation when conducting biomedical research. Covers the current version of the Tri-Council Policy Statement (TCPS) in detail.



## **Social and Behavioural Research Ethics** (EN)

Provides information about the ethical conduct of social and behavioural research with human participants. Covers the current version of the Tri-Council Policy Statement (TCPS) in detail.



## **Health Canada Division 5: Drugs for Clinical Trials Involving Humans** (EN & FR)

Covers all research subject to Division 5 and provides solutions and methods for complying with the Regulations. Successful completion of this course can be used as evidence of training in Division 5 Regulations.



## **Transportation of Dangerous Goods/International Air Transport Association (TDG/IATA)** (EN)

Specific training to ensure that all people conducting research with dangerous materials, agents or devices are in compliance with all applicable laws.



## **Responsible Conduct of Research in Life Sciences** (EN)

Provides a solid foundation of knowledge relating to the norms, principles, and rules governing responsible life science research practice in Canada.



## **Responsible Conduct of Research in Physical Sciences** (EN)

Provides a solid foundation of knowledge relating to the norms, principles, and rules governing responsible physical science research practice in Canada.



## **Privacy and Security for Personal Health Information (PHI)** (EN)

Introduction to privacy and security requirements for the Canadian health research environment with human participants. Includes information on the appropriate collection, use, dissemination, retention, and destruction of Personal Health Information.
